Condition:

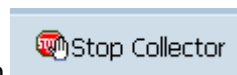
- Customer wishes to change the user that executes the EXTRACTOR batch job

Solution:

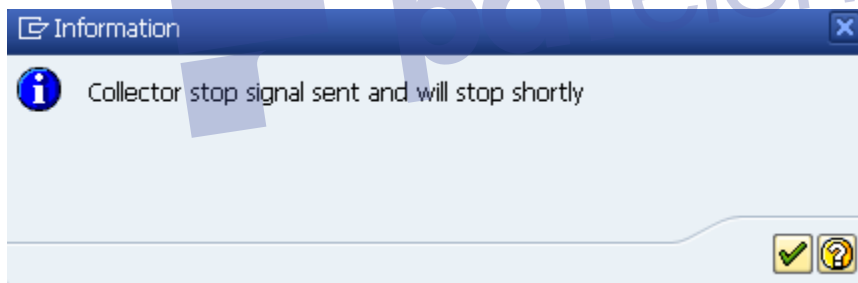
Start the PowerConnect control panel /n/BNWVS/MAIN



Stop the Collector using the **Stop Collector** button



Wait a few minutes for the collector to stop, when it stops the status icon will turn from a tick to a cross

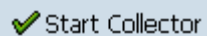
